CATS scores:

CATS (the Cognitive Abilities Test) is a diagnostic assessment that is designed to help boys and teachers understand how they learn and what their academic potential might be.

Year 6 Progress scores:

These external assessments are taken twice a year and are designed to test the progress of the boys in addition to flagging up specific areas in each of the core subjects where individuals or the cohort are performing exceptionally or are under performing. This then informs our academic planning.
