Dear Parents

Some good news to start the term: Over the break, Sutton Local Authority granted us planning permission to move forward with our scheme for improving some of the classrooms, halls, administration, library etc.

We are delighted with this outcome and anticipate getting started with works during the next academic year. It's particularly pleasing that we have the go-ahead for the scheme as we had hoped, as it will mean that there will be no need to put any of the boys into 'prefabs'. We will be able to build our new accommodation, move the boys in and remove the old building with the least disruption to normal life. This is great news for the smooth running of the school whilst we build.

We would love to share these plans and timelines in full, make time for you to meet our architects and deal with any questions you may have, with a launch event on the 10th June. We will also produce a comprehensive information pack for parents giving a display of the plans, elevations and projected timelines. I've also asked the architects to produce a 3D model for the boys, as we all know the boys love that sort of thing.

Moving forward with healthy food this week and your boy may have noticed that the School Kitchen now provides a snack for all boys at first break; for example, today we have flapjacks and brownies (which contain stealthy vegetables). This wonderful food is baked fresh each morning.

If parents would like to continue sending a snack in, for now, please feel free to continue, but this should not really be necessary in the future. I hope this service helps both the boys and parents. From next week, there will be routine Halal options on the menus, in addition to the existing meat and vegetarian selection. This will allow the many boys from Muslim families to enjoy something else instead of the vegetarian alternatives. I hope (Insha Allah!) these boys enjoy the new choice.


